Animal Of the Week: Tokay Gecko (*Gekko gekko*)



- The second largest gecko species in the world, native to southeastern and eastern Asia
- Tokay geckos often shelter in human homes
- Primarily insectivorous, but is known to eat small rats, mice, and snakes
- Tokay geckos are solitary outside of the breeding season and are aggressively territorial

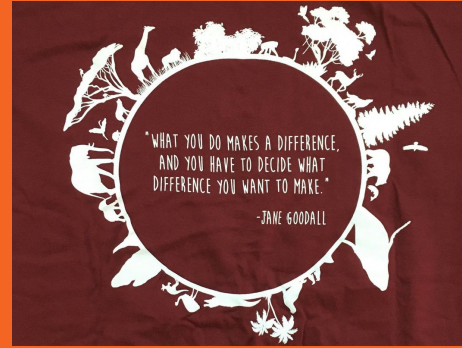
