ANIMAL OF THE WEEK: SPICEBUSH SWALLOWTAIL

- American swallowtail found in the eastern US
- Unlike other swallowtails, they tend to fly at fairly low elevations
- Larval colorations evolved to mimic snakes. They also turn bright yellow before they pupate!
- Adults mimic another poisonous swallowtail

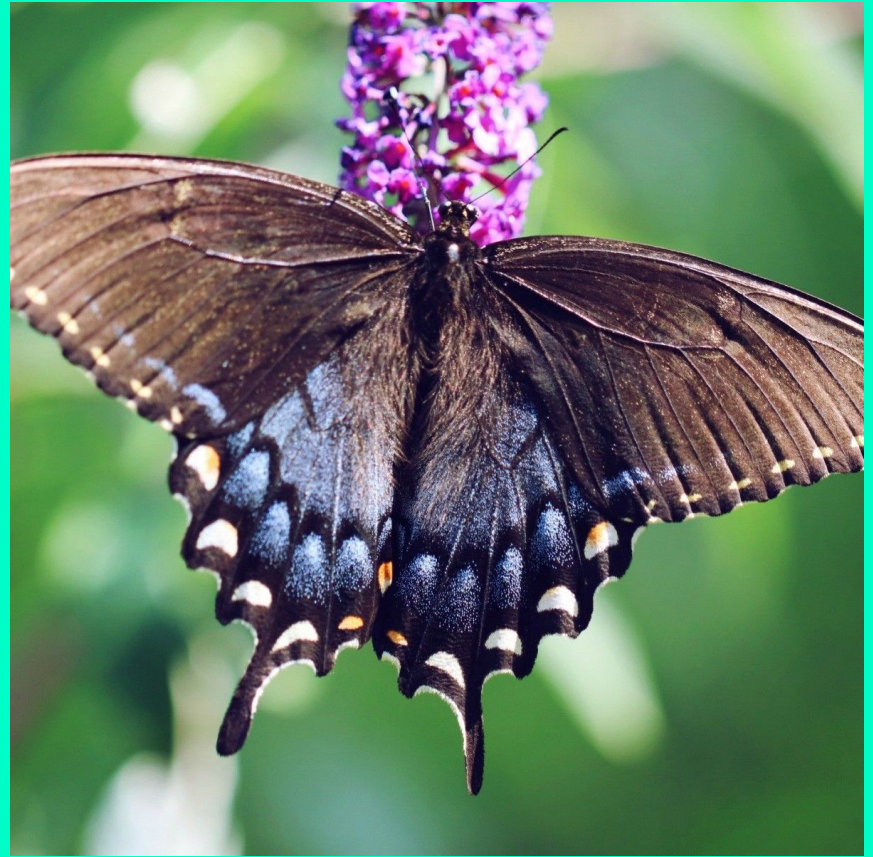

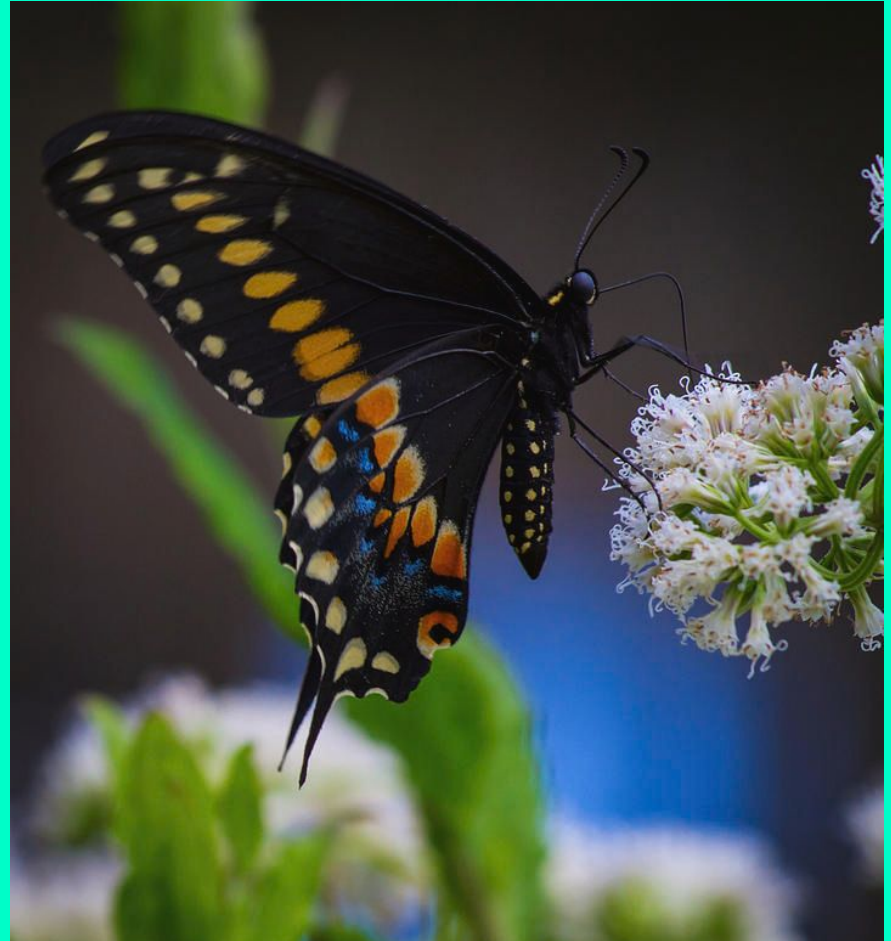

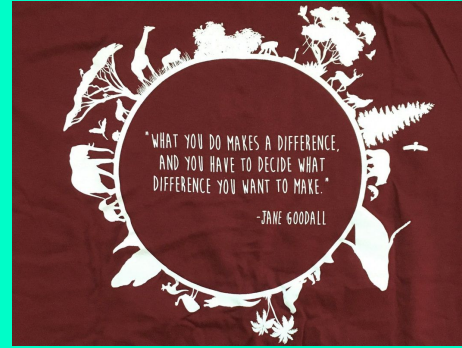


FUNDRAISING
