Animal of the Week: Scaly-Foot Snail (*Chrysomallon squamiferum*)

- Only found in deep-sea hydrothermal vents in the Indian Ocean
- Shell has three layers, which it builds itself: outer layer: iron sulfides, middle layer: periostracum, inner layer: aragonite
- Its foot is armored with iron scales
- It is a chemoautotroph, although very little is known about their diet.
